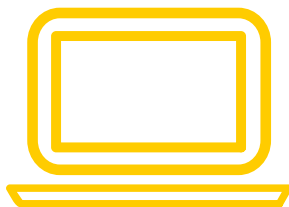


LSTA Funds at Work in RI

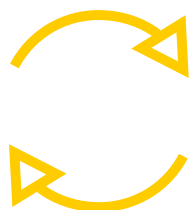
